

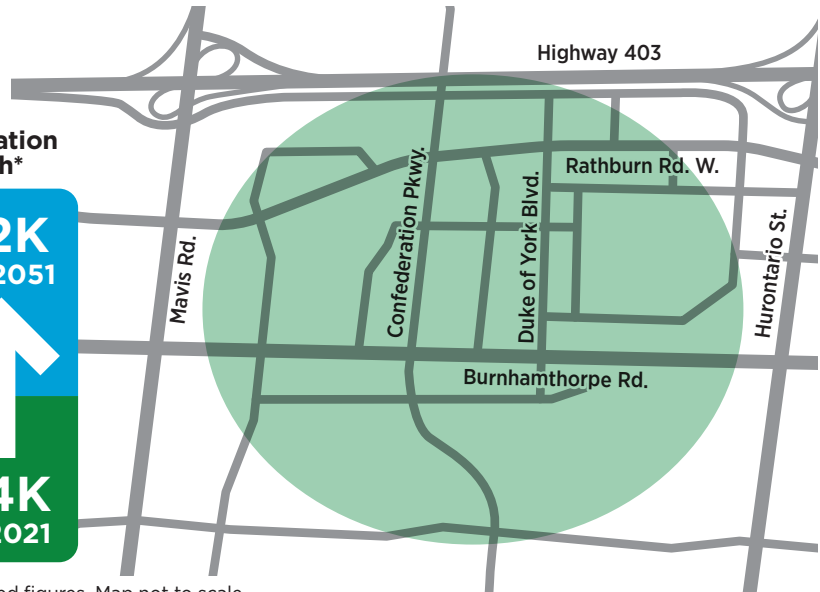
Bringing More Transit to Mississauga's Growing Downtown

Increased Frequency

*During Peak Service

Current design: 7.5 minutes between trains on Hurontario Street

With the Loop: 2.5 minutes between trains to downtown and 5 minutes between trains on Hurontario Street
