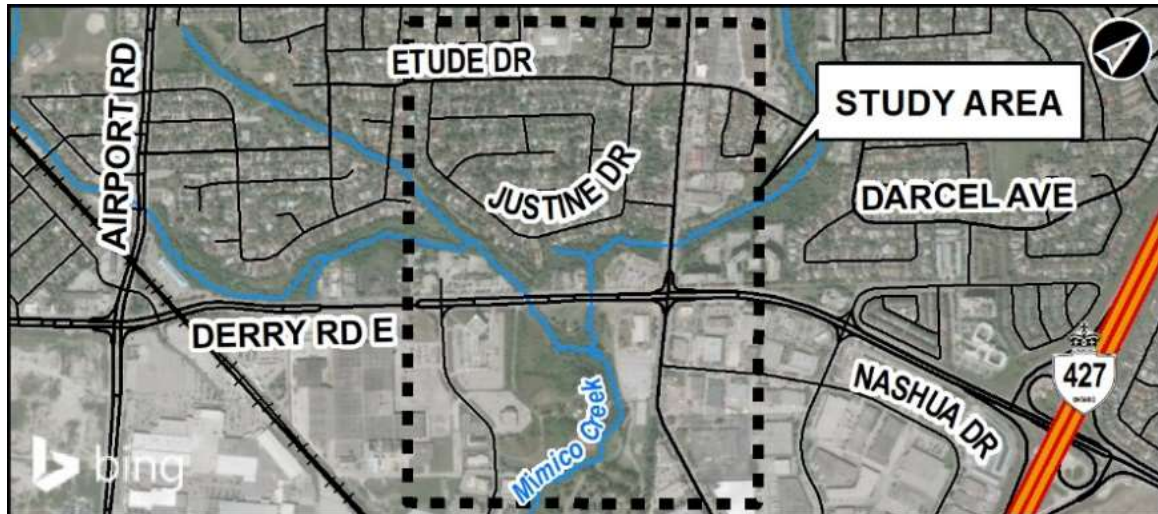


# CITY OF MISSISSAUGA – NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

## Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study: Malton Flood Mitigation Study – Etude Drive to Justine Drive

### What?

- The City of Mississauga is undertaking a Schedule B Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study to develop a flood mitigation plan for the general area between Etude Drive and Justine Drive in the Malton community.



### Why?

- The purpose of the project is to mitigate urban flooding risks to people, property and infrastructure for the Etude Drive to Justine Drive area (see above map).

### How?

- The Study will characterize and model the existing conditions of the area to propose mitigation measures and identify potential impacts.
- The Class EA process will involve identifying and evaluating various alternative solutions to help mitigate flooding, including the preferred solution.
- A Project File documenting the Class EA process will be available for public review at the end of the study.

### Public Consultation

- The City would like anyone with an interest in the Study to have an opportunity to provide input and help inform the decision-making process.
- An online Public Information Centre (PIC) will be posted to the City's webpage starting June 16, 2023 to present the findings of the Class EA study. The PIC will be a narrated presentation that will review the study's purpose, work completed to date and present the alternatives, including the preliminary preferred solution.
- The PIC will also summarize the feedback received from residents, how impacts are being addressed, next steps and how to stay engaged. Feedback is encouraged and comments are requested by **July 19, 2023**.
