

Fact Sheet: 2024 Capital Works Planned Construction Projects

The following projects are planned for 2024 as part of the City of Mississauga's Roads and Stormwater Capital Programs:

Road resurfacing

- Residential Road Resurfacing – 34 streets amounting to 13.3 km
- Major and Industrial Road Resurfacing – 8 streets amounting to 12.95 km
- Nine streets resurfaced from multi-year projects and carry-over from 2023, amounting to 14.05 km.

Creek, erosion control work and stormwater management facility projects

- Construction of a pumping station at the south-east corner of Doug Leavens Blvd and the Lisgar channel
- Etobicoke Creek erosion control and rehabilitation (Ponytrail Drive to Bloor Street)
- Sawmill Creek erosion control and rehabilitation (Folkway Drive to Erin Mills Parkway)
- Sheridan Creek erosion control and rehabilitation (Lushes Avenue to behind Fletchers Valley Crescent)
- Cooksville Creek improvement and flood protection and replacement of King Street Bridge
- Central Parkway Transitway Storm Water Management Improvements
- Cooksville Creek improvement and flood protection
- Malton Flood Relief Project (Etude Drive to Justine Drive), including construction of a stormwater box culvert beneath the pedestrian walkway, full reconstruction of the walkway to safely create an overland flow route, and an upgraded outfall structure and channel in Derry Greenway Park
- Dredging and rehabilitation of Dixie Road Bus Rapid Transit pond
- Dredging and rehabilitation of Tomken Road Bus Rapid Transit pond

Other road projects

- Bloor Street Redesign: Improvements planned as part of this project will help make roads safer and more accessible to pedestrians, cyclists and transit users. These improvements include road rehabilitation work, cycling facilities, road safety improvements and landscaping work.
- Port Credit Active Transportation Bridge
- Central Parkway Bus Rapid Transit Station improvements
- Intersection Improvement Program (MiWay), includes installation of dedicated bus lanes (Queue jump lanes), new bus bays and enhanced bus shelters at Mavis Road and Derry Road intersection and Cawthra Road and Arbor Court (outside of Carmen Corbasson Community Centre) intersection

Other work

- Construction of 140 m of new noise walls (Dundas Street W, east and west of Erin Mills Parkway)
- Construction of 3.55 km of new sidewalk as part of the Road Resurfacing Program, construction of 2 km of new sidewalk as part of 2024 Sidewalk Program, and construction of 13.305 km of sidewalk from multi-year projects and carry-over from 2023, for a total of 18.86km
- Construction of two new retaining walls on Dundas Street West (Erindale Park entrance east of Robinson Street)
- Replacement of retaining walls on Meadow Wood Road, Brookhurst Drive and Seagull Drive
- Torbram Sanitary Sewer Tunneling under Metrolinx Tracks

Continuing multi-year projects

Eight projects from 2023 are continuing into 2024:

- The rehabilitation of The Collegeway Integrated Road Project
 - In 2024, includes completion of 5 km of new sidewalk and 2.2 km of multi-use trail.
- Rathburn Road and Ponytrail Drive Integrated Road Project
 - In 2024, includes completion of 5 km of new sidewalk, 0.5 km of new noise wall and 3 km of new multi-use trail.
- McKenzie Park Storm Water Management Facility
 - In 2024, includes 0.05 km of new sidewalk.
- Goreway Separation Project
 - In 2024, includes 0.74 km of new sidewalk and multi-use trail.
- Burnhamthorpe Road Bridge over Credit River
- Smoke Tree Pumping Station
 - Includes 0.025 km of new sidewalk and 0.04 km of new multi-use trail.
- Southdown-Truscott Enhanced Road Project
 - In 2024, includes 0.71 km of new multi-use trail, 0.33 km of new cycle tracks and 0.75 km of new sidewalk.
- Work along five multi-use trails for a total of 1.25 km.
 - Kos-Andros Walkway (Kos Blvd to Andros Blvd)
 - Eglinton Avenue West (Metcalfe Avenue to Driveway East of Metcalfe Avenue)
 - Creditview (Financial Drive to Old Creditview Road)
 - Creditview (Argentia Road to 40m west of Argentia Road)
 - Cardiff Blvd (Mount Charles Park to Derry Road East)
