

Garage Safety



Store hazardous materials away from any source of heat, sparks or flame.



Store gasoline in tightly capped, labelled and approved containers. The maximum you can store is 30 litres.



Always use a licensed electrical contractor to inspect and install additional circuits, outlets and to complete any repairs.

Do not empty smoking materials directly into the garbage.



Extension cords bring temporary power. They are not for longterm use.



Frequently dispose of flammable & combustible materials that are no longer needed.



Never cook or barbecue inside the garage.



Never run a vehicle, engine or motor with fuel (lawn mowers or snow blowers) in the garage.
