

Fireworks

If you choose to use fireworks, know the rules first.



Fireworks cause thousands of injuries each year.



Consider colourful banners, streamers, or glowsticks instead of fireworks!



You can **only** set off fireworks at home on the following holidays:

Between 6:00pm-10:00pm
Lunar New Year
Victoria Day
Canada Day
Diwali

Between 11:00pm-1:00am
New Year's Eve



Roman candles are prohibited.



Fireworks may only be used on private property that you own or have written permission to use.



Never set off fireworks near individuals or on public property like parks, streets or sidewalks, boulevards, or any other city-owned property.



Safely dispose of used or unused fireworks by submerging them in water overnight before throwing them out. Never put fireworks in the recycling or a regular trash can.



Fireworks can harm wildlife. Do not discharge fireworks near ravines, unmowed fields or wooded areas.
