

Inclusionary Zoning Update and Amendment (All Wards)

# **Location of the Proposal**



The lands affected by this Amendment are located in protected Major Transit Station Areas (MTSAs):

- Along the Hurontario Street Light Rail Transit route from the southernmost point to Matheson Boulevard West, including MTSAs located in the Downtown Core;
- Along the 407 Bus Rapid Transit route (Derry and Britannia MTSAs);
- Along the future Lakeshore Road East Bus Rapid Transit route (Lakefront Promenade, Haig, and Dixie MTSAs); and
- Along the Dundas Street Bus Rapid Transit route.

**Proposed changes:** The City of Mississauga is proposing to make changes to Inclusionary Zoning in the Official Plan and Zoning By-law to:

- Revise the Inclusionary Zoning (IZ) set-aside rates in the Official Plan and Zoning By-law so that the 2024 IZ rates remain in effect until an updated assessment report is completed.
- Revise Official Plan policies with a housekeeping amendment to address transition, the Region of Peel, and legislative changes regarding parking in protected MTSAs.
