Request for a License Agreement for use of waterfront locations Non-Motorized Recreational Water-based Activity Providers

The Corporation of the City of Mississauga invites offers from applicants interested in entering into a License Agreement to utilize a portion of the waterfront to supply, operate and manage their non-motorized recreational water-based activity rental services and/or lessons, at one of the following locations:

1. Lakefront Promenade Park – 120 Lakefront Promenade
2. R.K. McMillan Park- 622 Lakeside Avenue
3. A.E. Crookes Park – 140 Lakefront Promenade

The initial term of the License Agreement will be for 1 year, with the potential to extend for one additional year.

- **March 28, 2025 (midnight)** – proposal submission Closing Date. Proposals to be submitted to Melanie Hartman at melanie.hartman@mississauga.ca. Applicant submissions received past the Closing Date will not be considered.
- City Committee staff will review and evaluate the submissions. Following evaluation, Melanie Hartman will contact the successful applicant to confirm whether The City of Mississauga will proceed to negotiate a License Agreement. The City of Mississauga reserves the right to negotiate with only those parties that the City of Mississauga so determines in its sole discretion.

 - *The EOI package and information to be provided by applicants do not bind the City of Mississauga or the prospective licensee in any way. Its purpose is for interested parties to demonstrate their wish to license the property from the City of Mississauga and to initiate correspondence on the matter.*
