Hello,

Thank you for writing and sharing your election priorities for the City of Mississauga. Our full platform, Our Plan to Protect Ontario, was released today and has measures that will protect Mississauga along with its residents and businesses.

A re-elected PC government will continue to make historic investments in public transit by delivering multiple new GO lines, enable expanded two-way, all-day service on the Milton and Kitchener lines, build dozens of new stations and add convenient connections to existing transit systems across the Greater Golden Horseshoe, while also helping secure good-paying jobs for Ontario workers in the face of President Trump's tariff threats.

The Ontario government also invested \$325 million in critical water infrastructure projects to help build up to 107,000 new homes across the province. The funding is being delivered through the Housing-Enabling Water Systems Fund (HEWSF), which helps municipalities build, repair, rehabilitate and expand critical drinking water, wastewater and stormwater infrastructure. The Municipal Housing Infrastructure Program is also providing funding for core infrastructure projects, such as roads and water systems, to support growing and developing communities.

In regards to flooding, the Province administers the Flood Hazard Identification and Mapping Program (FHIMP), to protect people and property from flooding, direct new development away from high-risk areas and identify areas where flood-proofing or other measures may be required to manage risks to communities. The program provides up to \$15 million in funding for flood mapping projects in Ontario and is now accepting applications for funding from municipalities through April 2027. The PC government also recently introduced the *Emergency Management Modernization Act*. The proposed legislation aims to update and strengthen the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act* (EMCPA), ensuring a more effective, coordinated and comprehensive approach to provincial and municipal emergency prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery efforts.

We're committed to supporting Peel Regional Police to keep Mississauga safe. We recently invested \$1.5 million in Peel Police to Project CARE, to support the hiring of additional officers so the Intimate Partner Violence Unit can respond to the current level of calls for service and provide additional specialized trauma support and care to victims. We also provided Peel Regional Police a \$900,000 grant through the Preventing Auto Theft grant to combat vehicle thefts.
