

2025 Capital Works Planned Construction Projects

The following projects are planned for 2025 as part of the City of Mississauga's Roads and Stormwater Capital Programs:

Road resurfacing

- Resurfacing 72 roads, amounting to 30.2 kilometres. Damaged curbs, culverts, gutters and sidewalk sections will be replaced.

Flooding, creek erosion control work and stormwater management facility projects

- Construction of the Doug Leavens Boulevard pumping station to reduce basement water infiltration in the Lisgar district.
- Reconstruction of the stormwater management pond at the Central Parkway Transitway.
- Malton Flood Relief Project, includes installation of storm sewer between Etude drive and Mimico Creek, roadworks and landscape.
- Replacement of Mattawa Avenue sanitary sewer for Peel Region and upsizing of storm sewer infrastructure (includes full road reconstruction).
- Rehabilitation and dredging of two stormwater management ponds at Dixie Road and Tomken Road.
- Cooksville Creek improvements and flood protection, includes culvert removal, installation of new King Street bridge, road rehabilitation, retaining walls and associated works.
- Etobicoke Creek erosion control and rehabilitation (behind 74000 Pacific Circle).
- Cooksville Creek erosion control (from Mississauga Valley Boulevard to the CP Railway bridge).
- Sawmill Creek erosion control and rehabilitation (from Folkway Drive to Erin Mills Parkway).
- Mimico Creek erosion control (downstream of Etude Drive, upstream side of Derry Road, behind Justine Drive).
- Sheridan Creek erosion control and rehabilitation (Lushes Avenue to Fletchers Valley Crescent).

Rehabilitation of bridge and culvert structures

- Repair of Scarboro Street culvert, over west branch of Mimico Creek.
- Rehabilitation of the Burnhamthorpe Road West bridges over Mullet Creek.

- Construction will begin on a multi-year project to build a new active transportation bridge in Port Credit, including construction of new cycling facilities, pedestrian crossings, drainage infrastructure, traffic signals and street lighting and intersection improvements.
- Construction will begin on a multi-year project to widen Ninth Line (between Eglinton Avenue West and Derry Road West), with improvements for all road users, including cyclists, pedestrians, transit users and motorists.
- Improvements to the Living Arts Drive active transportation infrastructure from Burnhamthorpe Road West to Rathburn Road West, including pavement rehabilitation, intersection upgrades, pedestrian crossings and pathways and new protected bike lanes.
- Replacement of pedestrian bridge on Battleford Road.
- The Credit Woodlands Integrated Road Project.
- Mavis Road slope stabilization.
- Central Parkway BRT Station improvement, including new bus loop.

Other projects

- Construction of 590 metres of noise walls along Winston Churchill Boulevard (east side, from Unity Gate to Burnhamthorpe Road West).
- Construction of 3.74 kilometres of sidewalk through the 2025 Sidewalk Installation Program.

Continuing multi-year projects

Eight projects from 2024 are continuing into 2025:

- Rathburn and Ponytrail Drive Integrated Road Project (Restoration work only).
- Rehabilitation of The Collegeway (Restoration work only).
- Rehabilitation of the Burnhamthorpe bridges over the Credit River.
- Dundas Street retaining wall.
- Smoke Tree Pumping Station.
- Goreway Drive Grade Separation Project.
- Sidewalks to be completed this year from the 2024 Sidewalk Installation Program:
 - Living Arts Drive from 75 metres north of Princess Royal Drive to 130 metres North of Princess Royal Drive.
 - Bren Road from Rena Road to road's end.
 - Traders Boulevard East from Whittle Road to Kennedy Road.
 - Britannia Road west from Snowy Owl Crescent to Clover Ridge Crescent.
- Intersection Improvements:
 - Darcel Avenue and Dunranken Drive.
 - Derry Road and Mavis Road.
 - Mavis Fire Station 121.
