

Notice of Study Commencement and Public Information Centre #1

Square One Drive and City Centre Drive

The Studies

The City of Mississauga has initiated two concurrent Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) studies for Square One Drive and City Centre Drive in Mississauga's City Centre.

The Class EA studies build on the recommendations in the City's Downtown Movement Plan (2024), which identified the need for a multi-modal fine-grained street network in downtown Mississauga and recommended the extension of:

- Square One Drive from Hurontario Street to Rathburn Road East and Shipp Drive, and
- City Centre Drive from Kariya Gate to Hurontario Street and Burnhamthorpe Road West.

The Class EA studies will assess the need and examine alternatives for the potential extensions of Square One Drive and City Centre Drive.

The Process

The Class EA studies have been initiated as Schedule B projects in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (2024), which is a planning and design process approved under the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*. The studies will identify problems or opportunities and evaluate alternative solutions considering natural, social, cultural, and economic environmental impacts. Two Public Information Centres are planned at key milestones to share study updates and invite public comments.


Public Information Centre
