WHEREAS in December, 2020, Council adopted a recommendation to opt-in to the Provincial Electric Kick-style Scooters ("e-scooter") Pilot Program to permit and regulate the use of e-scooters in the City of Mississauga;

AND WHEREAS the City's Traffic, Transit and Parks By-laws were amended in February 2021 to permit the use of e-scooters in Mississauga ("the City's e-scooter permissions");

AND WHEREAS the City launched its Shared Micro-mobility Program in June 2024 with service providers Bird Canada and Lime Technologies Inc. offering e-bikes and e-scooters for short-term rental;

AND WHEREAS between 2023 and 2025, the Credit Valley Hospital and the Mississauga Hospital recorded 738 e-scooter-related Emergency Department visits, with a year-over-year increase during this period;

AND WHEREAS the most common injuries include fractures, sprains, lacerations and head injuries resulting from falls, collisions, multiple riders on a single scooter, failure to follow traffic signals, or riding on sidewalks where interactions with pedestrians increase risk;

AND WHEREAS many of these injuries appear to be preventable through proper education on the use of e-scooters, the required protective equipment, and the existing rules for safe e-scooter use set out in Provincial regulations and City by-laws; and

AND WHEREAS Peel Regional Police have expressed their own concerns with their ability to effectively enforce the ubiquitous use of e-scooters in Mississauga, including many circumstances where officers are unable to safely pursue riders who fail to comply with traffic laws or municipal by-laws due to the inherent risk such pursuits would pose to the rider, pedestrians, and the public.

Therefore be it resolved that:

1. That staff coordinate with the vendors (Bird and Lime) and Peel Police to collectively establish and enhance their safety measures.
2. That staff work on greater public awareness and education measures related to the use of e-scooters.
