Here are a few simple ways to make a big difference during your stay.

Top five quick tips for being a great guest

Sort garbage, recycling, and organics correctly



2

Only park in designated areas



3

No street parking between 2-6am



4

Typically, keep noise down after 11pm



5

Keep the property tidy and clear of debris.

Noise: be considerate

Mind the hours

- Keep music and pets quiet before 9am and after 7pm
- Outdoor noise without amplification (e.g., cheering, gatherings, sporting activities) is allowed:
Monday-Saturday: 7am-11pm
Sunday & statutory holidays: 9am-11pm
- Excessive noise may result in fines

Serious situations

- Causing a disturbance such as fighting or aggressive behaviour, is a police matter. Call Peel Regional Police if assistance is needed

Stay safe: be prepared

Parking: respect the rules

Park responsibly

- Street parking is allowed for up to 5 hours unless posted otherwise
- No street parking between 2 and 6am
- Never block sidewalks, driveways, fire hydrants, or fire routes with your car
- Do not park on grass
- If it's snowing don't park on the road
- For longer stays, ask your host about temporary parking permits

- Tickets and towing may occur if rules aren't followed

Property care: keep it safe and tidy

Seasonal tips

- Grass and yards must be maintained. If it's getting long, let your host know
- If snow or ice accumulates, inform your host for removal

Yard cleanliness

- Never leave garbage bags or bulky items outside
- Keep the property clear of debris
- Do not leave food outside - this attracts wildlife
- Report any damage or hazards immediately (loose railings, broken steps, etc.)

Garbage & recycling: keep it clean

Sort your waste properly

Use the bins provided at the property:

- **Grey bin (garbage):** food wrap, lids, plastic cutlery, bottle caps, diapers, pet waste
- **Blue bin (recycling):** aluminum trays, flattened cardboard, plastic containers, bottles, jars (caps go in garbage), newspapers, envelopes
- **Green bin (organics):** tissues, paper towels, food scraps, tea bags, coffee grounds, greasy pizza boxes

Bulky items (e.g., furniture): never leave these items outside - ask your host for disposal instructions

Keep bins out of sight

- Store bins neatly in the garage, backyard, or side yard
- Only bring them to the curb after 7pm the night before pickup
- Return them promptly after collection

Avoid overflow

- Bin lids must close completely
- Break down boxes and containers to save space
- For extra garbage, ask your host about garbage tags or drop-off options
