



FILING YOUR NOMINATION PAPER CHECKLIST – FILING IN PERSON

In order to complete your nomination, you must complete the items and steps on this checklist.

Download and print the Nomination Package from https://mississaugavotes.ca/for-candidates/become-a-candidate/ OR book an appointment through the City of Mississauga’s online appointment booking system to pick up the blank forms.	
Complete the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Nomination Paper – Form 1 • Endorsement of Nomination – Form 2 (<i>not required for persons filing nominations for school board trustee</i>) • The Candidate Declaration • Access to Candidate Contact Information • City of Mississauga Sign By-law Acknowledgement • Confirmation of Name on Ballot Form • Primary Certificate of Maximum Campaign Expenses • Certificate of Permitted Amount of Contributions to a Candidate’s Own Campaign – (Required only for Mayor and Ward Councillor candidates) • Filing Your Nomination Paper Checklist – Filing Electronically 	
Once your forms are completed book an appointment through the City’s online appointment booking system to submit your paperwork.	
At your appointment you must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit the completed forms listed above • Provide your identification proving your name and qualifying address. If you chose a name for the ballot other than the legal name that appears on your identification, you must bring proof that you otherwise go by that name. Proof may include a business card or a bill • Submit your nomination fee of \$200 for candidates for Mayor and \$100 for candidates running for municipal office or school board trustee. Only credit and debit card payments will be accepted 	
Once all of the above are completed, an election official will sign your nomination form as being received and you can begin campaigning
