

Certificate of Permitted Amount of Contributions to a Candidate's Own Campaign: 2024 By-election

Permitted amount of contributions to a candidate's own campaign

In accordance with section 33.0.2(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* as amended (MEA), the following is your initial certificate of permitted amount of contributions to a candidate's own campaign (self-funding limit). These numbers are based on the 2022 electoral population. You will be provided with a final certificate in April 2024. The higher of the two will be considered your maximum self-funding limit.

I, Diana Rusnov, City Clerk for the City of Mississauga, hereby certify that the maximum permitted amount of contributions to a candidate's own campaign for the Mayoral or Ward 5 Councillor Municipal By-Election, to be held in the City of Mississauga on June 10, 2024 is as follows:

Office	Self Funding Limit
Mayoral Candidates The calculation is based on the following formula: \$7,500 plus \$0.20 cents per eligible electors to a maximum of \$25,000*.	\$25,000.00
Councillor, Ward 5 Candidates The calculation is based on the following formula: \$5,000 plus \$0.20 cents per eligible electors to a maximum of \$25,000*.	\$14,828.40

This is the total amount you and your spouse can contribute to your campaign combined.

Campaign Contributions

If you accept campaign contributions from other people, you are responsible for ensuring:

1. That your contributors understand that they are allowed to contribute up to \$1,200 to an individual candidate; and
2. If a contributor plans to contribute to multiple candidates, the total amount they are allowed to contribute is \$5,000

If you contribute to another campaign, you are subject to the same contribution limits. In accordance with the MEA, your name and address will be provided on the candidate's financial statement and posted online. Similarly, if you accept contributions, you are required to provide the name and addresses of your contributors on your Financial Statement and your Financial Statement will be posted online. You are responsible for relaying this information to your contributors.
