



## CANDIDATE DECLARATION

Mississauga's 2026 General Election:

### Do Solemnly Declare That:

1. I am:

- at least eighteen years of age;
- a Canadian citizen; and
- qualified pursuant to the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* and the *Municipal Act, 2001* and the *Education Act, 1990* to be elected to and to hold the office for which I am nominated and am not otherwise ineligible by law.

I am NOT:

- prohibited from voting in the general election according to the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* or the *Education Act, 1990*;
- a member of the Assembly as provided in the *Legislative Assembly Act* or of the Senate or House of Commons of Canada unless I provide proof of my resignation in a form satisfactory to the Clerk of the City of Mississauga prior to 2:00 p.m. on August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2026 which is Nomination Day, (last day a nomination can be filed);
- ineligible because of a conviction of a corrupt practice under subsection 91(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act*;
- ineligible because of a contravention of subsection 88.23(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act* related to improper financial filing; and
- a public servant within the meaning of the *Public Service of Ontario Act, 2006*, except in accordance with Part V of that Act.

2. If I am filing a nomination form for **head of council or member of municipal council**, in addition to confirming the statements in paragraph 1:

I am:

- a resident of the City of Mississauga; or
- the owner or tenant of land in the City of Mississauga; or
- the spouse of such owner or tenant.

I am NOT:

- an employee of the City of Mississauga unless I have taken an unpaid leave of absence;
- an employee of municipal service board, transportation commission, public library board, board of health, police services board, planning board, or any other board, commission, committee, body or local authority established or exercising any power or authority under any general or special Act with respect to any of the affairs or purposes, including school purposes, of a municipality or of two or more municipalities or parts thereof; ("conseil local")

- a judge of any court;
- a person who holds an administrative position with the City of Mississauga;
- a clerk, treasurer, Integrity Commissioner, Auditor General, Ombudsman or registrar referred to in section 223.11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*;
- an investigator referred to in subsection 239.2(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*; and
- a Federal employee within the meaning of the *Public Service Employment Act*, unless I have followed and will continue to follow all the relevant provisions of Part 7 of such *Act*.

3. If I am filing a nomination form for **office of trustee on a district school board**, in addition to confirming the statements in paragraph 1:

I am:

- a resident of the area of jurisdiction of the board to which the nomination applies; or
- the owner or tenant of land in the applicable area of jurisdiction; or
- the spouse of such owner or tenant.

I am NOT:

- an employee of any district school board unless I have taken an unpaid leave of absence; and
- the clerk, treasurer, deputy clerk or deputy treasurer of any municipality unless I have taken an unpaid leave of absence.

I make this solemn Declaration conscientiously believing it to be true, and knowing that it is of the same force and effect as if made under oath and by virtue of the *Canada Evidence Act*.
