

INTERIM CERTIFICATE OF MAXIMUM EXPENSES AND EXPENSES RELATED TO PARTIES AND OTHER EXPRESSIONS OF APPRECIATION AFTER VOTING DAY FOR THIRD PARTY ADVERTISERS

In accordance with subsections 88.21(6) and 88.21(9) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* as amended, this certificate sets out the interim maximum expenses permitted for Third Party Advertisers and the interim spending limit for expenses related to parties and other expressions of appreciation after voting day. These numbers are based on the 2022 electoral population. **In September 2026**, you will be provided with a final certificate of maximum campaign expenses and the spending limit for expenses related to parties and other expressions of appreciation after voting day.

This maximum expense limit is based on Section 7 of Ontario Regulation 101/97 which prescribes the following formula: \$5,000 + \$0.05 per elector to a maximum of \$25,000
