Flower Craft

Using items found around the house, create a beautiful flower project.

Time to complete: 1.5 hrs. +

Age Group: 7+yrs. (parent supervision may be needed)

Materials:

- Canvas or think cardboard (5x7 or 8x10 works well)
- Craft paint
- Paintbrush, sponge, fingers
- Material for flowerpot base (scrap material, foam, popsicle sticks- get creative)
- Small twigs for stems
- Orange, lemon or lime
- Glue (glue gun is ideal)



Instructions:

- 1. Paint the canvas or cardboard background
- 2. Use any colour or painting technique
- 3. Peel a citrus fruit. Shape the pieces into petals (parent supervision when using peeler or knife)
- 4. Take the material for the flowerpot base and shape it if required
- 5. When the background is dried, glue the base on.
- 6. Arrange the fruit peel petals into a flower design. Glue them to the background.
- 7. Add the twigs for the flower stems.
- 8. Enjoy a delicious fruit snack or fruity water with the leftover fruit while you enjoy your masterpiece.
