

## COVID -19 Participation Recreation Support Program



All campers are expected to comply with all applicable health and safety laws, including the *Occupational Health and Safety Act* and the advice and instructions of public health officials, including matters regarding physical distancing. The Corporation of the City of Mississauga may impose additional health and safety guidelines and requirements. In an effort to ensure the safest camp experience, we need to complete this intake.

<p>Does the child understand physical/social distancing- with some reminders can they maintain physical distancing.</p>
<p>Will your child understand if they are asked to move back or away from others?</p>
<p>Will the child be able to practice hand-washing routines several times a day? If the child is unable to practice hand washing, will they be able to apply hand sanitizer on their own with verbal instruction.</p>
<p>Camp will occur outside (rain or shine) and campers need to dress according to the weather and have appropriate non-breakable water containers, sunscreen, hats etc.</p>
<p>Does the child require personal care support (i.e., toileting, diapering, feeding, support with mobility)? If <b>YES</b>, external support will be required to attend with the child for the full program or will not be able to attend camp due to Provincial recommendations and increased potential to transmit COVID 19 virus</p>
<p>Do you as a parent/caregiver acknowledge that participants must adhere to public health officials' physical distancing rules, personal hygiene, participant declaration of health rules and Recreation's behaviour management policy to ensure the safety of your child and all other participants and staff?</p>
<p>Do you as a parent/caregiver, also acknowledge and agree to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• External supports are required to provide their own PPE and responsible for ensuring the participant maintains a 2metre distance from staff and other participants.</li><li>• Based on provincial guidelines, including health and safety requirements, City of Mississauga staff will do their best to maintain the 2 meter distancing between support staff and participant. As physical distancing is not always possible, our support staff will be wearing mask/face covering and face shields.</li><li>• Additional screening questions will be asked at the beginning of each camp day.</li><li>• Attendance at camp is guided by the requirements of government and public health officials. All requirements must be met in order to attend camp.</li></ul>
