

# Easter egg salt art

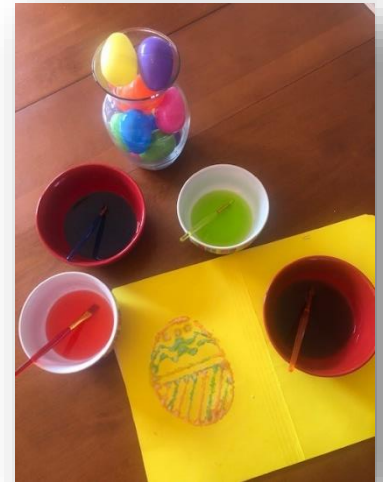
Salt art painting is a fun way to add texture and colour to a project. Make your own Easter Egg!

**Time to complete:** 30 min.

**Age Group:** 4yrs+

## Materials:

- Food Colouring
- Bowls of water
- Salt
- White Glue
- Paper
- Paint Brush



## Instructions:

1. Decide what colours you would like to make your Easter Egg and add 1 – 2 drops of the colour into the bowls of water.
2. Draw an Easter Egg with fun designs on paper with white glue.
3. While the white glue is still wet, pour salt all over the design. Pick up paper and let excess salt fall off onto another piece of paper or plate.
4. Dip brush into the bowl of coloured water and dab the colour onto the salt (do not brush the colour across).
5. Keep dabbing until all of the salt is covered. The colour may bleed and create swirls and blends of colours.
6. Let dry completely before picking up your painting. These paintings are not forever paintings and may begin to flake within a week.
