DIY Mini Mummy Piñata

Make your own personal piñata to hide Halloween treats for you or family!

Time to complete: 30 min.

Age Group: 6+ (may need some parental help)

Materials/Supplies:

Paper roll (TP)

- Crepe paper (streamer kind preferably white)
- Halloween candy (any kind you like)
- Googly eyes
- Regular tape, double sided tape or glue
- String or twine
- Construction paper for tag

Activity instructions:

- 1. Assemble your supplies
- 2. Cover the paper roll with pieces of crepe paper. Lay over top in a crisscross pattern completely covering the top. Tape ends to the sides of the roll.
- 3. Turn the roll upside down and fill with a <u>few pieces</u> of candy (don't over fill full)
- 4. Make a pull tag with construction paper and string. Attach your tag to the string. Create a big loop with the string attached to the tag.
- 5. Add a message to your tag (i.e. happy Halloween pull me!)
 Now you are ready to close the top and wrap your mummy!
- 6. Make two slits on either side of a piece of crepe. Attach the string under the piece. Cover the open end with crepe paper and make sure the pull tag is attached before covering it with crepe paper. Cover the top like the bottom (and don't forget to make slits in the crepe paper for the sting). See picture example.



- 7. Wrap the crepe paper once around the roll securing with tape or glue to make your roll look like a mummy
- 8. Add your googly eyes with glue
- 9. Roll crepe paper from bottom to top push apart some of the paper at the top of the roll for the googly eyes to peek out. Secure with glue or tape

Now your mummy piñata is ready. Pull the tag and surprise yourself or your little trick or treater with Halloween treats! (See top of page for finished project)
